### WHAT IS PEER LINK?

ARC’s Patient Education & Empowerment Resource, PEER Link, is a one-to-one support program that offers amyloidosis patients and caregivers the opportunity to connect with a trained peer mentor around a shared experience.

Peers are matched with mentors based on type of amyloidosis, age, life stage, and other factors that allow for mutual understanding. Mentors are trained in basic supportive counseling skills, are regularly updated about advances in amyloidosis care and community resources, and are committed to confidentiality.

The PEER Link program is built to help those who are newer to the amyloidosis community or are experiencing a transition.
